Update

Ryan Oneal Boatner, 27, was apprehended by the Baton Rouge Police K-9 division around 2:15am this morning in a backyard in the 8300 block of Green Moss Dr.

Boatner was transported to a local hospital for minor injuries.

Boatner will be booked into East Baton Rouge Parish Prison and charged will 4 Counts to Attempt 1st Degree Murder, Attempt Armed Robbery, Criminal Damage to Property and Simple Escape.

Baton Rouge Police are actively searching for Ryan Oneal Boatner, 27, [4751 Wilma St](#), who fled police while in custody at the VCU Office, [7901 Independence Blvd](#). Boatner was taken into custody for robbing four individuals at [4555 Charles St](#) around 2:00pm today.

Boatner and a 29 year old man, entered the home demanding their personal belongings while holding a handgun. The 29 year old suspect began firing upon the victims, striking two of them.

One of the victims returned fire, striking the 29 year old suspect. Boatner and this suspect fled the scene in a vehicle with an awaiting driver, Warren Jackson, 27, [4714 Parks Oaks Dr](#).

The injured suspect was transported by personal vehicle to a local hospital where they were apprehended.

The victims were transported to a local hospital with minor injuries. The injured suspect is in the hospital with life threatening injuries.

Jackson was booked into East Baton Rouge Parish Prison with Accessory After the Fact to Attempt 1st Degree Murder and Armed Robbery.
