BATON ROUGE DOCTOR ARRESTED

Dr. RANDY J. LAMARTINIERE, 57 of 8858 Phaeton Crossing has been arrested by members of the Tactical Diversion Squad – Group 29, consisting of the Baton Rouge Police Department, Drug Enforcement Agency (DEA), Louisiana State Police, East Baton Rouge Sheriff's Office and the Iberville Parish Sheriff's Office, on charges of 24 counts of Distribution of Schedule II Narcotics, 2 counts of Distribution of Schedule III Narcotics and 5 counts of Distribution of Schedule IV Narcotics.

LAMARTINIERE was issued a Summary Suspension in Part from the Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners 630 Camp Street, New Orleans LA. This Suspension restricted him from prescribing, dispensing, or administering Controlled Substances to any patient effective December 30, 2015.

Investigators learned that LAMARTINIERE violated the Summary Suspension by continuing to prescribe medications which were being filled in surrounding areas of Baton Rouge.

The total narcotics prescribed by LAMARTINIERE while under the above suspension are as follows: 3,205 dosage units of Schedule II, 44 dosage units of Schedule III, 330 dosage units of Schedule IV. The majority of prescriptions were prescribed and/or filled between Jan 4, 2016 and Jan 5, 2016.

LAMARTINIERE was later booked in the East Baton Rouge Parish Prison.
