BANK ROBBERY INVESTIGATION - UPDATE

GREGORY CHISOLM, 51 of 843 Camp St., New Orleans, LA., is wanted in connection with the robbery of Chase Bank, 3012 Government St., which occurred on January 12, 2016.

Baton Rouge Police Detectives are attempting to identify the individual in the attached photograph who is accused of robbing the Chase Bank, 3012 Government St. today around 9:40am.

The suspect entered the business and approached a teller window with a note demanding money. As the suspect obtained an undisclosed amount of money, he dropped a suspicious item into the teller window and fled the business on foot.

Baton Rouge Police Explosives Unit arrived on scene and rendered the non-explosive device safe.

The suspect is identified as a black male, 40-45 years old, around 6'0" wearing a green flannel shirt, green pants, and brown boots with a green beanie cap.
