Update

The Baton Rouge Special Response Team arrested Miketrez Jones, 22, 1916 Mulberry St, earlier today for pointing a firearm at BRPD Officers and fleeing on foot after a traffic crash on Saturday, January 17, 2015.

Jones will be booked into East Baton Rouge Parish and charged with Aggravated Assault Upon a Peace Officer with a firearm, Resisting a Police Officer by Force or Violence.

Jacob Washington, 21, received additional charges of Principal to Aggravated Upon a Peace Officer with a firearm, Principal to Resisting a Police Officer by Force or Violence and Obstruction of Justice. (Washington was already in East Baton Rouge Parish Prison on related charges)

Baton Rouge Police Investigators have arrested JACOB WASHINGTON, 21 of [5375 Fairfields Ave](#) on charges of Aggravated Flight from an Officer, Obedience to a Traffic Control Device, Stop Sign Violation and Careless Operation of a Motor Vehicle.

Today around 12:30pm two Baton Rouge Police Motorcycle Officers attempted to stop a Nissan Altima, being driven by Washington, in the [1400 block of Plank Road](#) for a traffic violation. Washington refused to stop as he continued violating multiple traffic violations in the immediate area in an attempt to elude the officers. Washington then crashed while attempting to turn onto Bellvale Ave from Plank Rd.

After the crash the passenger exited the vehicle and pointed a firearm at one of the officers. At this time the other officer observed the firearm and fired a single shot at the suspect. The suspect then fled the scene on foot as Washington was taken into custody. It is unknown if the suspect sustained any injuries.

Neither officer suffered any injuries from the incident.

Washington was later booked into the East Baton Rouge Parish Prison on charges of Aggravated Flight from an Officer, Obedience to a Traffic Control Device, Stop Sign Violation and Careless Operation of a Motor Vehicle.
