MAN ARRESTED FOR COUNTERFEIT BILLS

JUSTIN RUSHING, 31, 18383 VAN BROUSSARD, PRAIRIEVILLE, LA, was arrested by Baton Rouge Police for Monetary Instrument Abuse (6cts), Misdemeanor Theft, Possession of Schedule I Drug, Possession of Schedule II Drug, Possession of Schedule IV Drug and Contraband Prohibited in a Penal Institution.

Police made contact with Rushing at 11100 Mead Rd on February 9, 2016 around 2:00pm after he passed a counterfeit bill early in the day at a local business. After doing a search of Rushing's vehicle, officers located counterfeit money (undisclosed amount), paper, tools for a printer, and a trimmer which are commonly used to manufacture counterfeit bills.

Officers also confiscated narcotics during his booking into East Baton Rouge Prison.
