Larry Sherman, 30, was arrested yesterday without incident in New Orleans, La. during a traffic stop for 5 counts of felony theft. Sherman has been scamming people for money.

LARRY ANTHONY SHERMAN, 30 of 6214 Villa Ashley Dr. is wanted in connection with several thefts totaling around \$8600.00.

On three known occasions, SHERMAN posted an ad on Craigslist attempting to sell used vehicles. The first incident occurred on November 27, 2013 as SHERMAN listed a 2002 Toyota Camry for \$2,800.00. The second incident occurred on December 2, 2013 as SHERMAN listed a 2006 Nissan Maxima for \$3,000. The third incident occurred on January 16, 2014 as SHERMAN listed a vehicle for 2,800 which was located at an auction yard.

In each incident SHERMAN would meet the potential buyers, collect the money and then disappear without ever producing the vehicle.
