## Man Arrested for Negligent Homicide

### Update

ADONIS FORBES, 25, 2014 TENNESSEE ST, was arrested last night and charged with Negligent Homicide in the shooting death of Murrain Hawkins, 13, 3405 Myrtlelawn St.

Hawkins was babysitting Forbes's children when he returned home to check on them. Forbes was working on his handgun when it accidentally fired, striking Hawkins in the torso area.

### Original

At approximately 2100 hours on 02-21-2015 Uniform Patrol Officers (2<sup>nd</sup> District) were dispatched to 2014 Tennessee street relative to a shooting. On arrival Officers located juvenile B/M suffering from apparent gunshot wound to the abdomen lying on the ground. A shooter was located and taken into custody, with preliminary information indicating the shooting was accidental. Name of Victim and suspect will not be released at this time. EMS arrived on the scene and transported victim to local hospital where he was pronounced dead. Homicide Division was notified and responded to the scene and the investigation was turned over to them.
