SHOOTING ON BRADY STREET – UPDATE

Update 02-22-16

Baton Rouge Police Detectives learned that the firearm used in this shooting was stolen. The suspect was re-booked into the East Baton Rouge Parish Juvenile Detention on the charges of Negligent Homicide and Illegal Possession of a Stolen Firearm.

Update 02-20-16

Darneisha Williams, 16, 3811 Brady St, died today from gunshot wounds sustained in an accidental shooting that occurred on February 18, 2016.

This shooting is still under investigation.

Original 02-18-16

Baton Rouge Police Detectives are investigating a shooting of a 16 year old female that occurred today around 5:00pm at 3811 Brady Street. The victim was found inside her residence suffering from a gunshot wound to the head.

Detectives learned that the victim was accidentally shot by a relative, a 16 year old male, while playing with a firearm. It hasn't been determined where the firearm was obtained. The victim was transported to a local hospital where she remains in critical condition

The suspect was later booked into the East Baton Rouge Parish Juvenile Detention on charges of Negligent Injuring and Illegal Possession of a Firearm by a Juvenile.
