Update 02-24-14

Baton Rouge Police Detectives have arrested COLODIUSE BOWIE, 35 and JAMEEKA BOWIE, 18 both of 1108 St. Joseph Street. The two were arrested on 02-20-14 around 10:20am on charges of Obstruction of Justice in connection with the shooting death of Patrick Williams.

COLODIUSE BOWIE, the mother of the accused shooter Devon Bowie, and JAMEEKA BOWIE, the sister of Devon Bowie, were both inside the residence at the time of the shooting. COLODIUSE fled the residence with Devon immediately after the shooting, and went into hiding to avoid questioning. COLODIUSE initially denied being at the residence at the time of the shooting, but later admitted to being present. JAMEEKA was untruthful with detectives, as she attempted to cover for COLODIUSE by saying that she wasn't inside the residence at the time of the shooting.

COLODIUSE and JAMEEKA were later booked into the East Baton Rouge Parish Prison on charges of Obstruction of Justice.

Update 01-18-14

Devon Bowie, 19, turned himself in to police authorities yesterday afternoon for 2nd Degree Murder and Illegal Use of a Weapon.

Update 01-16-14

Baton Rouge Police Detectives have issued an arrest warrant for DEVON BOWIE, 19, of 1108 St Joseph Street, for 2nd Degree Murder and Illegal Use of a Weapon.

BOWIE is accused of shooting his cousin, Patrick Williams, after a confrontation from an ongoing dispute. Patrick Williams died on scene, as BOWIE fled the area in a 1998 Oldsmobile Aurora, 4 door white in color bearing LA Temporary Tag # 15352005.

BOWIE is identified as a black male, 5'10", 135 -140lbs.
