Update to North 30th St Shooting

Update

QUINTIN THOMAS, 26, 4545 EARL GROS, was arrested yesterday as a fugitive in Lafayette, La and booked into East Baton Rouge Parish Prison early this morning for 1st Degree Murder, Attempt 1st Degree Murder and Illegal Use of a Weapon. Thomas is accused of killing Idalis Smith, 18, and injuring a 34 year old man during a shooting that occurred inside a residence on March 20, 2015 around 1:00pm.

Thomas's girlfriend, VICTORIA GUILLORY, 23, 4545 EARL GROS, was also arrested for Accessory After the Fact to 1st Degree Murder.

The motive is unknown at this time and this incident is still under investigation.

IDALIS SMITH, 18, 1305 NORTH 30TH ST, was found shot to death inside her home around 1:00pm today. Police also found a 34 year old man suffering from gunshot wounds. The male victim was transported to a local hospital and is in critical condition.

Police believe someone shot both victims and fled the scene prior to police arrival.
