## UPDATE TO QUIDA MAE SHOOTING

### Update 03-27-15

YOVANNI ANIBAL ROMOS-SALAZAR, 31, turned himself in to police authorities yesterday afternoon without incident.

Romos-Salazar was booked into East Baton Rouge Parish Prison and charged with Second Degree Murder and Illegal Use of a Weapon.

### Update 03-24-15

Baton Rouge Police Detectives believe that the YOVANNI ANIBAL ROMOS-SALAZAR shot and killed Joel Guevara after learning that Guevara raped one of his family members.

### Update 03-23-15

YOVANNI ANIBAL RAMOS-SALAZAR a 31 year old Hispanic male, around 5'9", 165 pounds of 5852 Quida Mae #110, is wanted in connection of the shooting death of Joel Guevara.

### Original 03-23-15

Baton Rouge Police Detectives are investigating the shooting death of Joel Guevara, 28 of 5852 Quida Mae #104. Guevara was shot multiple times outside of his residence last night around 8:00pm after a brief argument with another male suspect.

Guevara died at his residence as a result of his injuries.
