ARREST MADE IN FORGERY SCHEME

Baton Rouge Police Detectives have arrested THOMAS BENNETT, 28 of 1416 Delplaza Drive, today on charges of Forgery, Identification Theft, Access Device Fraud (2cts) and Attempted Misdemeanor Theft (50.00).

Investigators believe that on February 6, 2017, BENNETT, accompanied by accomplice, KALEIGH SULLIVAN, arrived at the Regions Bank, 3121 South Sherwood Forest Blvd., in order to negotiate a stolen/forged check. Prior to officers arriving, BENNETT fled the area leaving SULLIVAN behind. Investigators were advised by SULLIVAN that the check was taken during vehicle burglaries that the two committed in the Albany area.

Investigators learned that BENNETT is currently incarcerated in the East Baton Rouge Parish Prison on unrelated charges. BENNETT will be booked in the East Baton Rouge Parish Prison on the charges of Forgery, Identification Theft, Access Device Fraud (2cts) and Attempted Misdemeanor Theft.
