Charges Upgraded in Blvd De Province Shooting

Update

Jonathan Robinson, 21, 556 East Bolivar, died on April 14, 2015 from gunshot injuries that were sustained from a shooting that occurred in the roadway at 1972 Blvd De Province on April 8, 2015. Qwenton Bureau, 20 was arrested yesterday morning and charged with Negligent Homicide.

Troy Rhines II, 20, 8949 Metairie Dr and Keithin Johnson, 21, 5151 Highland Rd turned themselves in to police authorities yesterday morning and was charged with Accessory After the Fact to Negligent Homicide and Failure to Report Certain Felonies.

Update

QWENTON BUREAU, 20, 11384 CATAPLA, was arrested yesterday and charged with Attempt 2nd Degree Murder for shooting a 21 year old man in the head on April 8, 2015 around 10:00pm. The victim was found lying in the roadway at 1972 Blvd De Province.

At approximately 2200 hours 04-08-2015 Uniform Patrol Officers (3Rd District) were dispatched to 1972 Blvd De Province relative to a man down, bleeding from the head. On arrival Officers located the victim and found him to be unresponsive from what appeared to be a gunshot wound to the head. Another shooting scene was located in the BREC park 1735 Blvd De province, however preliminary investigation does not indicate if the two scenes are related. Victim was lying in the parking lot of this address and was transported by EMS to local hospital. The Violent Crime Division was notified and responded to the scene and the investigation was turned over to Violent Crime Detectives. No identification of victim was discovered at this time.
