JUVENILES LOCATED

Update 04-24-17

Rebekah Lemar and Jordan Erwin have been located today walking in the Livingston Parish area. Both appear to be safe and unharmed. Officials have notified their families.

The Baton Rouge Police Department is searching for the individuals in the attached photographs identified as Rebekah Lemar, 14 of Slidell, Louisiana, and Jordan Erwin, 15 of 12074 Newcastle Avenue. Lemar is a missing person through the Slidell Police Department. Erwin was reported missing through the Baton Rouge Police Department on April 22, 2017. Erwin is around 6'1", 170lbs with black hair and brown eyes.

Investigators believe that Lemar arrived at the Hobby Lobby parking lot, 1683 O'Neal Lane by Uber on April 22, 2017 around 4:30am, where she met Erwin. Investigators thought that the two entered the wooded area adjacent to the Hobby Lobby, but a search of the woods did not show any signs of them. Erwin suffers from multiple illnesses and is not in possession of his medication.
