DROWNING INVESTIGATION UPDATE

Update 04-26-15

The victims from this early morning incident have been identified as ANTON JOE (male), 25 of 1315 Bob Pettit #47 and ISHITA MAITY (female), 28 of 1221 Bob Pettit #21. Both are Indian descent and students of LSU.

Joe and Maity died early this afternoon at a local hospital.

At this time there are no obvious signs of foul play.

Original 04-26-15

At approximately 0109 hours on 04-26-2015 Uniform Patrol Officers (2nd District) responded to 1315 Bob Pettit relative to unresponsive subjects in the pool. On arrival Officers located two unresponsive subjects laying at the bottom of pool, one male and one female of middle eastern appearance. One Officer entered the pool retrieving subjects, both subjects were transported to local hospital by EMS. Preliminary investigation indicates that the subjects may have entered the pool area by jumping the fence. Officers found the pool closed and gate locked. The Violent Crime Division was notified and responded to the scene and the investigation was turned over to Violent Crime Detectives. No identification of victims were confirmed at this time.
