Police Searching for Scammer

Baton Rouge Police Detectives have issued an arrest warrant for DUSTIN KENNETH GANT, 32. Gant is wanted for 2 counts of Misdemeanor Theft and Theft of the Assets of an Aged Person.

In April 2015, the suspect went to the various homes in the Baton Rouge area with the pretense of performing odd jobs. Gant failed to complete the jobs after receiving money.

Gant was convicted in September 2014 for Felony Theft of the Assets of an Aged Person.

Police believe there are other victims in the Baton Rouge area and encourage anyone who may have been scammed or who may know Gant's whereabouts is urged to contact the Financial Crimes Division at 389-3871 or Crime Stoppers at 344-7867.
