## **Arrest Made in Louisiana Ave Shooting**

### Update

Curtis King, 25, was charged with 2nd Degree Murder on June 17, 2015. King is accused of shooting and killing Taylor Latham, 1247 Louisiana Ave.

King was already in East Baton Rouge Parish Prison for Aggravated Kidnapping.

### Original

Curtis King, 24, and Daaria Thomas, 22, both living at 16441 South Harrell's Ferry Dr, St John Apartments, have been arrested and charged with Aggravated Kidnapping of a Child. King has an added charge of Possession with Intent to Distribute Schedule I. Both were arrested on May 4, 2015.

Police picked up both suspects around 9:00am this morning for questioning. During the course of the investigation police learned that King removed A'Kyleana Lathem from her residence early Saturday morning and transported her to their home.

Both suspects dropped A'Kyleana off at a Women's Help Center around 1:00pm yesterday afternoon.

In May 2013, King was under investigation after his 1 month old son, Aiden King, was rushed to a local hospital for burns from scalding hot water. King was arrested in November 2013 after his son, 6 months of age, died while in his care. King was charged with 2nd Degree Murder and 2nd Degree Cruelty to Juveniles.

He was out on bond and is currently awaiting trial.
