## CRUELTY TO A JUVENILE ARREST

ROSE HOLLAND 49, of 1762 N. 46<sup>th</sup> St., has been arrested today around 12:00am on charges of Possession of Schedule 2(Crack Cocaine), Possession of Drug Paraphernalia and 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree Cruelty to a Juvenile.

Baton Rouge Police responded to 1762 N.46<sup>th</sup> St., in reference to a loud music complaint. As officers arrived on scene, Holland was observed sitting in a vehicle parked in front of the residence. Holland was instructed to go inside the residence and turn the music down. Before Holland exited the vehicle officers observed a clear glass pipe with pieces of what appeared to be crack cocaine.

Officers later observed Holland's 15 year old son lying on a cot in her bedroom appearing to be having a seizure. The child was covered in feces and urine as roaches crawled on him. Officers noticed that the child appeared extremely malnourished with a large bedsore and multiple bug bites all over his body.

The child was transported by EMS to a local hospital.

Holland was later booked in the East Baton Rouge Parish Prison on charges of Possession of Schedule 2(Crack Cocaine), Possession of Drug Paraphernalia and 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree Cruelty to a Juvenile.
