Update 07-11-14

The victim in the fatal crash which occurred last night in the 3300 block of E. Brookstown has been identified as DARIUS MARKIE FISHER, 23 of 6311 Rockwood Court. Fisher died on scene.

Baton Rouge Police Traffic Homicide Investigators believe that Fisher was struck by another vehicle prior to being struck by the 2000 Honda Accord. The Honda was proceeding southbound on E. Bookstown when Fisher was struck. The 23 year old driver of the Honda wasn't injured.

Original 07-11-14

At approximately 2243 hours, on July-11-2014 Uniform Patrol Officers (1st District) responded to 3300 E. Brookstown, relative to a B/M lying in the roadway. Prior to Officers arrival another call was received that a B/M was struck by a vehicle. Upon Officers arrival to scene it was ascertain that a B/M was lodged under a vehicle. This B/M was found to be unresponsive and displaying no signs of life. EMS arrived on the scene and examined the B/M and pronounced him deceased. The Traffic Homicide Division was notified and responded to the scene and the investigation was turned over to Traffic Homicide investigators.
