N.48th STREET SHOOTING

Baton Rouge Police Detectives are investigating a drive by shooting which occurred last night around 7:00pm in the 1600 block of N.48th Street.

JAMES PAYNE, 25 of 1618 N.48th died on scene from apparent gunshot wounds. A second victim, identified as a 31 year old male, was transported to a local hospital with life threatening injuries.

There are no known motives or suspects at this time.
