MAIGAN SCOTT, 20 year old female, of 2920 Sherwood Street has been arrested this afternoon around 4:29pm on charges of Hit and Run Driving, Negligent Injuring, Driver License Required, Insurance Required and Switched License Plate.

SCOTT, while driving a tan colored Oldsmobile Cutlass westbound in the 2500 block of Washington Avenue, struck a 6 year old girl on her bicycle as the girl entered the roadway. SCOTT then fled to a residence on N.18<sup>th</sup> Street offering no aid to the child. Baton Rouge Police 1<sup>st</sup> District Uniform Patrol Units were able to locate the vehicle which led to SCOTT'S arrest.

The child was taken to a local medical facility where she remains in critical condition.

SCOTT was later booked into the East Baton Rouge Parish Prison.
