Update 09-22-14

Today around 9:40am JEROME LAMAR VERRET, 23 of 3026 Monroe Ave. arrived at Fourth District, 8227 Scenic Hwy, to turn himself in for his involvement in the shooting which occurred on September 14, 2014.

VERRET didn't make any statements.

VERRET was later booked into the East Baton Rouge Parish Prison on the charge of Attempted 1st Degree Murder.

Original 09-18-14

JEROME LAMAR VERRET, 23 of 3026 Monroe Ave is wanted in connection of shooting two individuals on September 14, 2014 around 2:45am in the 1200 block of Bob Pettit Blvd.

VERRET pulled out a pistol during a verbal altercation and shot a 23 year old male in the right leg, and a 20 year old male in the abdomen.

Both victims are expected to survive.

VERRET is wanted on charges of Attempt 1st Degree Murder.
