CHRISTOPHER STILLS was apprehended today around 12:30pm by the U.S. Marshalls at 6985 Greenwell Street.

STILLS will be later booked into the East Baton Rouge Parish Prison on charges of Attempted 2nd Degree Murder, Felon in Possession of a Handgun and Illegal Use of a Weapon.

Update 10-15-14

Baton Rouge Police have issued and arrest warrant for Christopher Stills, 21. Stills is accused of shooting Emanuel Burton, 38, in the head on October 13, 2014 in the 1700 block of Louisiana Ave.

The motive for this shooting is unknown at this time. Stills is wanted for Attempted 2nd Degree Murder, Felon in Possession of a Handgun and Illegal Use of a Weapon.

Baton Rouge Police Detectives are investigating a shooting which occurred on October 13, 2014 around 8:00pm in the [1700 block of Louisiana Avenue](#).

The 39 year old male victim was transported to a local hospital with life threatening injuries sustained from a gunshot wound to his upper extremities.
