Update 10-16-14

Baton Rouge Police Detectives have arrested NATASHA TATE, 40 along with DONTE TATE, 20 both of 4248 Cannon St., and DANNY ALLEN, 26 of 2201 Fairchild St. on the charge of Obstruction of Justice in connection with the arrest of HARDY ALLEN.

NATASHA TATE, DONTE TATE and DANNY ALLEN are relatives of HARDY ALLEN. After the arrest of HARDY ALLEN the three individuals contacted a key witness on the phone and began making verbal threats against her, along with being seen parked outside her residence.

NATASHA TATE, DONTE TATE and DANNY ALLEN were later booked into the East Baton Rouge Parish Prison on charges of Obstruction of Justice.

Update 10-15-14

Hardy Allen, 21, 3815 Eaton St, was arrested today by police for shooting and killing Calvin Chrisentary, 21, during an armed robbery in the 5000 block of Madison Ave. Police received tips through Crime Stoppers that led to Allen's apprehension.

Allen was charged with 1st Degree Murder, Armed Robbery and Illegal Use of a Weapon.

Baton Rouge Police are investigating the shooting death of CALVIN CHRISENTARY, 21, [6424 UNDERWOOD ST.](#) Police responded to a shooting in the [5000 block of Madison Ave](#) around [8:44pm](#) last night, where Chrisentary was found suffering from a gunshot wound to the back.

Chrisentary was transported to a local hospital where he later died from his injuries.
