FELONY THEFT INVESTIGATION - UPDATE

Update 10-28-15

MICHAEL OWENS, 36 of 8302 Jade Avenue, along with DWAN PORBY, 20 (address unknown) have been arrested in connection with the Macy's theft investigation which occurred on August 31, 2015. Crime Stoppers received a tip which led to their arrest.

Porby was apprehended by authorities in Natchez, Mississippi on October 8, 2015 regarding unrelated charges and is awaiting extradition. Owens was booked in the East Baton Rouge Parish Prison on October 23, 2015 for Felony Theft.

This investigation remains ongoing.

Baton Rouge Police Detectives are attempting to identify the individuals in the attached photographs who are accused of stealing around \$4000.00 worth of undisclosed merchandise from Macy's, 9301 Cortana Place, on August 31, 2015 around 12:30pm.
