## **SCAMMER ARRESTED**

COREY COLEMAN, 46, was arrested yesterday by Baton Rouge Police for scams involving food distributors in and around the Baton Rouge area. Coleman would contact food distributors via telephone pretending to be employed by various hotels and restaurants.

Coleman would place orders for food items and meet with the delivery drivers at various locations throughout the city.

Coleman was booked into East Baton Rouge Parish Prison and charged with Felony Theft and Attempt Felony Theft. He was also arrested on warrants for Felony Theft from Gretna Police Department, Orleans Sheriff's Office and New Orleans Police Department.
